Patient: 25 Year Old Gelding Appaloosa Gelding

Presenting Complaint: Lameness LF Limb, on arrival determined a case of cellulitis to the LF limb. Heat was present in the leg, along with swelling and sensitivity to palpation. Pastern dermatitis was noted on all four limbs, most severe on the LF leg.

Clipped and washed affected areas with PhytoVet CK shampoo, made sure to dry affected areas thoroughly before application of SW60. Instructions were to shampoo affected areas every 3 days for 1-2 weeks or until recheck appointment. Keep area clean and as dry as possible, applying SW60 1 time daily for 1-2 weeks.

Recheck lameness and pastern dermatitis

No lameness was noted, pastern dermatitis on all four were greatly improved. Treatment plan was to continue treatment for another week, until all dermatitis was resolved.
